MVRC Projects Masterplan (SUZ)

Since we last met:

Refreshed Community Survey.

Infield Activation Community Survey Results

- 435 respondents.
- 89% Residents (388)
- How important are the following community amenities to you? [Rated as Very Important > 50%].
- Green spaces parks and gardens 86% of respondents.
- Activated public open spaces 76%.
- Sporting facilities 74%.
- Access to healthy and fresh foods eg farmers markets 65%
- Parking 57%
- Outdoor playgrounds 56%
- Top three (3) choices for what you would like to see incorporated into the future infield of the MVRC redevelopment project:
- Walking Track 230
- Community activities e.g. farmers markets 219
- Sporting and recreational facilities 216
- Landscaping and Greenery 212
- Play and social spaces 146
- Dog Park 88
- Urban Public Spaces 78
- Active Exercise equipment 54



MVRC Projects Masterplan (SUZ)

Racecourse Design Development

• Appointed Symal as ECI (Early Contractor Involvement) Contractor for the further design development of Racecourse Precinct. In progress.

<u>Infield Expression of Interest (EOI)</u>

- Infield EOI process continues.
- Shortlisting has occurred, however no final determination has been made.
- Activation of the infield will likely be via a staged approach.
- Objective remains to activate the infield in line with the Club's vision and objectives.
- The role will be to:
 - Serve as a vibrant community precinct for the broader Moonee Ponds region when not in use for racing operations and events.
 - o Grow customer and fan engagement at the MVRC by providing more diverse offerings on non-race days and year-round.
 - Diversify and strengthen the MVRC's revenue streams and overall financial results to help grow the longterm financial sustainability of the club.
- Club will continue engagement with Moonee Valley City Council, once a more consolidated position has been resolved.



MVP Planning Update



"Flora East & West" Planning Permit Granted (green shading on above diagram)

- Sales to Commence Q1 2025
- Construction commencement indication mid 2026 (post existing grandstand demolition).

"North South Road" Planning Permit Application (red shading on above diagram)


- Planning Permit was issued by Council on 20 August 2024
- The Permit includes proposed future pedestrian access to MVRC infield (stair and lift).
- Construction commencement indication early 2026 (in line with the existing grandstand demolition).



MVP Construction Update Cont.

Stonepine House & Trackside House

- Icon have continued structural pours above GF for both SPH & TSH and are now forming level 4 for both buildings
- Structure has been stripped to Ground floor and façade panels will commence install in late September.
- Works over the next few months will continue the pouring of the structural slabs and installing the façade
- Access to site remains through Feehan Avenue / MVRC
- Icon remain on track to complete in Spring 2025
